INSTRUCTIONS FOR TEACHERS AND FESTIVAL SITE CHAIRMAN

- Parent(s)/Guardian(s) are to be given complete instructions regarding the audition process for their SCJM. The teacher is responsible for discussing any necessary accommodations with the parent(s)/guardian of the junior entrant and for obtaining their written permission prior to submitting the Specially Capable Junior Musicians application to the Festival Site/State Festival Chairman.
- Information and instructions to the judge(s) at the time of the entrant's audition must be understood by the parent/guardian, teacher, and festival site chairman.
- Judges should be made aware of any accommodation(s) to the entrant's audition process prior to the entrant entering the audition room. It is the festival site chairman's responsibility to notify the judge(s) of adjustments.
- Any information listed on the judging form should be removed directly after the audition and handed to the parent/guardian for safekeeping.
- Neither the words "Specially Capable Junior Musician" nor the initials "SCJM" are to appear on the rating sheet, instructions to judges, nor placed on any Festival Cup or Certificate earned by the Junior Entrant.
- A copy of this form and the "Instructions to Judges" section must be given to the teacher and parent/guardian prior to the evaluation. The Festival Site Chairman should keep one copy of this form and the "Instructions to Judges" section until after the Area Festival is completed. The application form should be returned to the parent/guardian or teacher at the end of the festival season.
- The "Instruction to the Judges" section of this form should be given to the judge along with the entrant's rating sheet prior to the junior entrant's audition. At no time should the details of the entrant's condition be specified. Only accommodations should be listed. The "Instructions to Judges" section of the form must be given to the Festival Site Chairman directly after the evaluation takes place.
- This designation might be temporary or permanent. Some juniors may be able to return to standard rules at the parent's request.
- The application must be re-submitted in subsequent years. As entrants mature and grow, the need for different accommodations or the removal of this designation may be needed. The parent/guardian(s) must always be consulted regarding entry as a SCJM.
