Requirements

Entry Fee: \$10.00

Deadline: All required materials, and application must be submitted to the NFMC site, https://forms.nfmc-music.org/forms, by February 1 in the odd numbered years.

Required Data From Student:

• Native born or naturalized USA citizen.

Requested Data from College or Music School if applicable:

- Name, both addresses (home and school) of the student.
- His/her present professor, address, and professor's school.
- Number of years with this professor.
- Other vocal teachers; dates of study.
- Letters from both present professor and dean or chair of present school.

Repertoire Requirements:

- A video recording consisting of three arias from standard opera one from French, German, or Italian; one aria 20th century American opera; one aria, major oratorio; all in original language/key. Piano accompaniment only.
- Audition recording must be of the best quality available. ACCEPTABLE MEDIA FOR ALL
 COMPETITIONS: All competition performances must be submitted online via unedited video
 recordings. Due to file size, entrants may choose to upload their video performances to an UNLISTED
 YouTube channel and submit the links on a separate document via the NFMC application portal.
- List selections/composers.
- Length not more than 30 minutes.

- An entry fee of \$10.00 is required to be considered for this award. Visit www.nfmc-music.org/payment. .
- If not a member of a federated club, visit www.nfmc-music.org/payment to pay senior individual membership dues of \$70.00.
- Previous winners of this award may not enter.
