- Regular college/university summer term courses are not eligible for this competition.

PURPOSE:

To encourage increased programming and performance of American Music. To bring wider recognition to the American composer, stimulate public appreciation and awareness of United States American music, and broaden the knowledge of American repertory for artists, students and performing groups.

AWARDS:

1st Place Award of Merit - *\$500

RULES:

- A winner cannot win two years in succession.
- The application form (below) is to be completed and attached to the entry.

ENTRIES MUST INCLUDE INFORMATION ON:

- 1. American Music performed during the period May 15 August 15, annually. Attach the outline of all activities relating to: composers, composers present, programs, compositions, number of performances, size of audiences, dates and other relevant information. Include works of US composers only.
- 2. American Music promoted during above period. Attach the outline of all activities relating to event, composers-in-residence, visiting artists and lecturers, seminars, commissions granted, workshops, reading festivals and other pertinent information.
- 3. Judges' decision will be final. If no entrant meets the standards, no winner will be declared.
