The following repertory is required, with piano accompaniment, but does **NOT** need to be memorized:

- 2. Joseph Haydn Adagio from Concerto No. 2 in D (any edition)
- 3. Richard Strauss Finale from Concerto No. 1 in E-flat, Op. 11 (any edition)
- 4. Bernhard Heiden 1st Movement (Moderato) from Sonata for Horn and Piano (any edition)

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Submit the following materials to the NFMC website <u>https://forms.nfmc-music.org/forms/</u> not later than *March* 1.

- 1. The program should be recorded on the best quality equipment available. All competition performances must be submitted online via unedited digital video recordings. Due to file size, entrants may choose to upload their video performances to an UNLISTED YouTube channel and submit the links on a separate document via the NFMC application portal.
- 2. List of recorded repertoire. Include time (minutes: seconds) of each piece.
