

THE ANNE M. GANNETT AWARD FOR VETERANS

Biennial award (Odd Years)

The amount of the award is \$2,000.00*

REQUIREMENTS

Named for a Past President of the NFMC who served from 1941 to 1947. During her term, the NFMC engaged in a very effective war service program, extending to all areas where the U.S. Armed Forces served.

Purpose of the award is to provide financial assistance to veterans who are former music students who interrupted their education to serve in the U.S. Armed Forces and wish to resume music study in pursuit of a career in music.

1. Entrants must sign a statement certifying U.S. citizenship and stating if native born or naturalized.
2. There will be no discrimination because of age, race or religion. However, preference will be given to veterans who have served overseas.
3. Entrants may win First Place multiple times, but not consecutively.
4. Current forms must be used-no out of date forms will be considered for judging.
5. Entrants must have outstanding musical talent, excellent background, and the highest recommendations.
6. All required materials can be uploaded to the NFMC site, along with application form at www.nfmc-music.org/applicant-file-upload or must be received by Richard Dill, Chair, 5054 Blossom Point Drive, Indian Land, S.C. 29707, by May 1 in the odd numbered years.

- Three copies of the completed application (CA2-1). The application may be obtained from the Chairman, from NFMC headquarters or online at nfmc-music.org.
- Applications must be typed.
- Proof of a high school diploma or GED.
- Proof of acceptance or currently enrolled in an accredited college or university in pursuit of an undergraduate degree in the field of music.
- A copy of the entrant's discharge from military service.
- If possible, three programs on which the applicant or his/her compositions appeared.
- Six (6) letters of recommendation showing the applicant's worthiness, need, character, background, musical talent, and potential ability. These must be actual letters of recommendation, not copies of official evaluation forms.
- A \$20.00 entry fee payable to NFMC.
- One 30 minute performance/audition CD which must be playable on a CD player. **Computer generated CD's playable on computer only will be disqualified.**

Winner will be asked to submit their Social Security number and a completed W-9 form to the NFMC Treasurer (IRS requirement)
