REQUIREMENTS

PURPOSE: This award is for the pianist who prefers a collaborative performance experience.

ELIGIBILITY:

Each entrant must be a citizen of the United States.

Must have reached the 20th but not the 31st birthday by March 1 in the auditions year.

Must be a member of the National Federation of Music Clubs either through NFMC Senior Club membership or as an individual member. If not already a member, visit www.nfmc-music.org/payment to pay the annual senior individual membership dues of \$50.

This Award can only be won once by any entrant. No out of date forms will be accepted.

VOCAL AND INSTRUMENTAL COLLABORATIVE AUDITION: The audition is by digital recording. It must be of good quality and between 15 minutes (minimum) to 20 minutes (maximum) in length, accompanied by a list of the selections in the order performed and by the application form (available on NFMC website).

- 1) A portion of each repertoire piece should be included within the time limit.
- 2) A repertoire list must be followed.
- 3) The selections must *include and show*:
 - a) Technique
 - b) Lyricism – musical line
 - c) Various styles
- 4) The list of repertoire MUST be in the order recorded with the EXACT time in minutes and seconds for each selection.

REPERTOIRE:

- 1) Suggested repertoire for Vocal Collaboration: Early Italian selections, German Lied, French Chanson.
 - a) Required repertoire: One American composition.
- 2) Suggested repertoire for Instrumental Collaboration: One selection from each period of music.
 - a) Required Repertoire: One American composition.

THE ENTRY FEE: The entry fee is \$20.00. No refunds will be made. Entry fee can be paid at www.nfmc-music.org/payment.

APPLICATION: All required materials must be uploaded to the NFMC site, along with application form at www.nfmc-music.org/applicant-file-upload March 1.

*In the event of financial shortfalls, advertised award amounts may be adjusted. Applicants would be notified of the award change.
