ELIGIBILITY:

- 1. The competition is open to citizens of the United States, either by birth or naturalization.
- 2. The applicant must be between the ages of 19 and 26. (Must have reached the 19th but not the 26th birthday by the application deadline of *March* 1.)
- 3. Membership in the National Federation of Music Clubs is required, either through a student/ collegiate organization (i.e. a college/university/band/orchestra that is a member of NFMC) OR as an Individual Member. Visit www.nfmc-music.org/payment to pay individual dues.
- 4. An entrant may enter competitions in only one NFMC Division (i.e. Junior, Student/Collegiate, or Senior) in a year.
- 5. Former NFMC Bluhm winners are ineligible to compete a second time.
- 6. NFMC winners will be asked to provide a picture and give permission for publication of their success in NFMC publications.

REPERTOIRE REQUIREMENTS: (Memorization not required)

- First movement of a sonata or sonatina by Bach, Handel, Hindemith, Piston, Poulenc or Dutilleux.
- Choose one: Griffes *Poem*, Hanson *Serenade* or Kennan *Night Soliloguy*.
- Two compositions by a published American composer (not listed above).
- Performance length should be a minimum of 15 minutes but no longer than 20 minutes.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Upload the following materials to the NFMC website (www.nfmc-music.org/applicant-file-upload):

- Completed application form (ST 14-1). Note: Use current forms only. Out-of-date forms will not be considered for judging
- Uploaded unedited digital recording
- List of recorded repertoire. Include time (minutes: seconds) of each piece.
- Entries must be uploaded no later than *March* 1 of the competition year.

Note: NFMC winners will be required to submit their social security number to the NFMC treasurer (IRS requirement)
