Arts improve academic performance. Students engaged in arts learning have higher GPAs, standardized test scores, and college-going rates as well as lower drop-out rates. These academic benefits are reaped by students across all socio-economic strata. Yet the Department of Education reports that access to arts education for students of color is significantly lower than for their white peers. 91% of Americans believe that the arts are part of a well-rounded K-12 education. Arts strengthen the economy. The nation's arts and culture sector-nonprofit, commercial, education-is an \$876.7 billion industry that supports 4.6 million jobs (2020). That is 4.2% of the nation's economy-a larger share of GDP than powerhouse sectors such as agriculture, transportation, and utilities. The arts boast a \$33 billion international trade surplus (2019). The arts accelerate economic recovery: a growth in arts employment has a positive and causal effect on overall employment.
