## Rules for Judging TARBA Auditions:

The judges may not use a percentage method of rating or judging. Each contestant must receive a rank, as $1,2,3$, etc. Failure to comply with these rules invalidates the auditions.

In National Auditions, the contestant with the lowest total is the winner, provided two of the three judges have given a rating of " 1 ". The one with the largest total has the lowest final standing. Thus, above " $B$ " ranks first and is the winner, having both the lowest total and two " 1 " ratings; " $F$ " ranks second, though with the same total, for he/she has only one " 1 " rating. " $C$ " ranks third, " $E$ " fourth, etc.
