Applicants must be a citizen of the United States who have reached the 19th but not the 26th birthday by the application deadline. In order for the selection committee to review applications for NFMFC Music Therapy Scholarships, we will require the following materials.

1. Vita (typed and double-spaced, length to be determined by the applicant.)
2. Recommendation letter from the head of the Music Therapy Department at the applicant's schools  
A letter of recommendation from each of the following referring to the applicant's qualifications
  - a. A music faculty member outside the Music Therapy department
  - b. An acquaintance in the community
3. The competition is open to any citizen of the United States, either by birth or naturalization.
4. Membership in National Federation of Music Clubs. To pay the individual membership fee of \$16.00 for annual dues visit [www.nfmc-music.org/payment](http://www.nfmc-music.org/payment).
  - (a) Affiliated club or school
  - (b) Individual student/collegiate membership
5. Transcript of college credits and GPA The applicant should be classified as a sophomore, junior, senior or graduate (depending on the award) in a music therapy degree program approved by the American Music Therapy Association.

**VITA:**

Your vita should give a detailed work experience based on your activities, both as a student and in community related activities. Special emphasis should be placed on situations in which there is intensive use of musical interest or activities as the primary means of relating to the person or situation.

The applicant should also include personal goals and area of interest and financial arrangements (needs). The vita should include information on schools attended, training received, honors and organizations, and a review of your reasons for wanting to be a music therapist.

We appreciate your cooperation in completing and supplying the desired information.

The applicant must submit all required material to the NFMFC website <https://forms.nfmc-music.org/forms/> by March 1.
