Elaine can get products at half price. The group felt that project would be different from other vendors and make money for the Bucks for Brevard Campaign. It was suggested that Elaine contact NFMC President Lana Bailey for permission to be a vendor. Jimmie Walker will make a backdrop and help with designing the table.

The Bucks for Brevard Cookbook was tabled for now. Jimmie Walker volunteered to be the chairman.

Beth announced we will do our "Bucks for Brevard" Skit at the Southeast Region Luncheon in Pittsburgh.

In final business, Carolyn Nelson, NFMC President-Elect announced she will send around the list of available NFMC Chairmanships to the State Presidents so they can know what jobs will be available for the Federation.
